CHECKLIST OF ITEMS TO BRING TO CAMP:

Each day it is important to wear your riding gear to camp and also bring the following items with you if you are enrolled for multiple classes per day:

- Sunscreen
- Bug spray
- Comfortable change of shorts and shirt
- Sneakers
- Swim suit, towel and flip flops
- Lunch and snacks
- Refillable water bottle

Students should come each day wearing comfortable clothes for riding in. If you do not have proper riding attire, here are some acceptable substitutes: full length leggings or full length sweatpants (stretchy pants with no inseam). Please note that pants must cover all the legs, no large holes or shorts because students will get skin rubs and pinches if leg skin is exposed to the tack when riding. Pants such as jeans with a large inseam are uncomfortable and will usually **chaffe the riders so are not recommended. Socks are necessary and best when all the way up the calf length**, for riding. Shoes for riding must be either tie on or boots but NO SNEAKERS. They must have a flat heel such as paddock boots, hiking boots or rain boots. It is recommended to have actual riding boots because the way they are balanced aids the rider in keeping their feet in the stirrups and for foot protection around the horses. If you wish to purchase these, they can be found online at statelinetack.com. Locally there is Anytime Tack located in Burtonsville, Md. They have second hand riding apparel for kids and also offer a camp special. In Mount Airy there is Stablemates Tack Store. **SNEAKERS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE FOR RIDING IN THE SUMMER PROGRAM.** They may be worn before and after the riding portion of the program.

HEALTH INFORMATION:

A deposit of \$50. per student is required and must be included with Registration. Your deposit will be credited toward your final balance due. PLEASE NOTE: The \$50. deposit is required PER STUDENT,

not per session. If you are registering one student for multiple sessions the registration deposit is \$50. **Full payment, less the deposit, is due and will be collected on the first day of your chosen camp session.**

LIABILITY RELEASE

This RELEASE FROM LIABILITY is made and entered into on this ____ day of _____, 2021, by and between Out of the Box Stables, hereinafter designated MANAGERS/INSTRUCTORS and (Print the Rider's Name) _____, hereinafter designated RIDER; and if Rider is a minor, Rider's Parent or Legal Guardian (Print the Parent/Guardian Name if Rider is a Minor) _____.

In return for the use today, and on all future days, of property, facilities and services of ALL Manager/Instructors of Out of the Box Stables, LLC and Farm Owner. Out of the Box Stables, the Rider, his heirs, assigns and legal representatives, hereby expressly agree to the following: 1. Rider is responsible for full and complete insurance coverage on his/her owned horse, personal property and him/herself. 2. Rider understands there are risks in and around equine activities, and, that an equine activity sponsor and/or equine professional and/or Manager/Instructor is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, Rider, and/or Participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risk of equine activities. 3. RIDER PARENT/LEGAL GUARDIAN AGREES TO ASSUME ANY AND ALL RISKS INVOLVED IN OR ARISING FROM RIDER'S USE OF OR PRESENCE UPON FARM OWNER/MANAGER'S/INSTRUCTOR'S PROPERTY AND FACILITIES including, without limitation but not limited to: the risks of death, bodily injury, property damage, falls, kicks, bites, collisions with vehicles, horses or stationary objects, fire or explosion, the unavailability of emergency medical care, and/or the negligence and/or deliberate act of another. 4. Rider agrees to hold Manager/Instructor and all successors, assigns, subsidiaries, franchisees, affiliates, officers, directors, employees, farm owners and agents completely harmless and not liable and releases them from all liability whatsoever and AGREES NOT TO SUE them on account of or in connection with any claims, causes of action, injuries, damages, costs or expenses arising out of Rider's use of or presence upon Farm Owner, Manager's/Instructor's property and facilities, including without limitation, those based on death, bodily injury, property damage, including consequential damages, except if the damages are caused by the direct, willful and wanton gross negligence of the Manager/Instructor. 5. Rider agrees to waive the protections afforded by any Statute or law in any jurisdiction (e.g. California Civil Code Para. 1542) whose purpose, substance and/or effect is to provide that a general release shall not extend to claims, material or otherwise, which the person giving the release does not know or suspect to exist at the time of executing the release. 6. Rider/Parent/Legal Guardian agrees to indemnify and defend Manager/Instructor and all their agents and representatives against, and hold from Rider's use of or presence upon the Manager's/Instructor's property and facilities. 7. Rider/Parent/Legal Guardian agrees to abide by all of the Manager's/Instructor's rules and regulations, and Rider is responsible for using protective headgear, i.e. riding helmet and hard boots. 8. If Rider is using Rider's horse, the horse shall be free from infection, contagious or transmissible diseases. Manager/Instructor reserves the right to refuse any horse entry to the property if not in proper health or is deemed dangerous or undesirable. 9. This Contract is non-assignable and non-transferable and is made and entered into IN THE STATE OF MARYLAND and shall be enforced and interpreted under the laws of this state. Should any clause be in conflict with the State Law, then that clause is null and void. When the Manager/Instructor and Rider (and Rider's Parent/Legal Guardian if Rider is a minor) sign this release from Liability, it will then be binding on both parties, subject to the above Terms and Conditions.
